The First Reading: Isaiah 63:7-9

Isaiah extols the kindness of the LORD by reminding God's people of all that he has done for us. The LORD stood by his covenant even though his son, Israel, turned away from him. The LORD showed compassion and mercy to a people who did not deserve it. What but the kindness of God could look at Israel and us and still say, "Surely they are my people, sons who will not be false to me"?

The Psalm of the Day: Psalm 2 on page 65 in your Hymnal

The Epistle Reading: Galatians 4:4-7

He commissioned his own Son to become the God-man who subjected himself to law so that everyone under sin's curse might be bought back. The Incarnation of God meant that children of wrath could become the sons of God, and Pentecost proves our adoption as sons.

The Gospel Reading: Matthew 2:13-15, 19-23

At the birth of Christ, the angels announced good news and great joy meant for all people, but not everyone saw it that way: Herod reacted to the birth of Jesus with fear, opposition, and violence. The malice of Herod, however, could not rob the world of the peace God intended to bring through his Son. God cared for his Son and all the sons of God by using Joseph to keep him safe in the land of Egypt..

Seasonal Response: We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.
