The Psalm of the Day: Psalm 148 on page 121 in your Hymnal

The Epistle Reading: Galatians 4:4-7

Thousands of years had passed, generations had come and gone, since the promise made by God in the Garden. But all those years were not wasted, but preparatory. Finally, when everything had been perfectly prepared, God kept the Garden Promise and sent his Son.

The Verse of the Day: Alleluia. All the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God. Alleluia. (Psalm 98:3b)

The Gospel Reading: Luke 1:68-79

Zechariah had learned to trust God's promises. After months of silence, he bursts forth to sing of God's promises kept. Blessed be the God of Israel who has come to redeem his people.

Applying God's Word to our Lives this Week: Sermon: Luke 1:68-79 Theme: Zechariah's song of praise is our own!

Holy Communion: In Holy Communion we are receiving Jesus' true body and blood for the forgiveness of our sins, new life, and salvation. But that's not all. We also receive strength, encouragement, and comfort knowing that in this sacrament we are at one with our God through Jesus' death on the cross for our sins, we are one in faith with those communing beside us, and we are joined with all the saints, who share our common faith. For this reason we practice close communion, inviting only WELS or ELS members to partake of the sacrament so as not to call into question the communion that we share.
