### God speaks to us from the Scriptures:

The First Reading: Acts 4:8-12

Just like Jesus in the gospel reading Peter goes straight from the visible to the Word and from the outward but unseen manifestation of Christ's power in his resurrection to its inner power in the law which kills and condemns and the gospel which miraculously brings faith and life, forgiveness and salvation.

The Psalm of the Day: Psalm 118, p. 108 in your Hymnal

The Second Reading: 1 John 1:1-2:2

Everything which the apostles had seen and heard is there to be received, shared, enjoyed in the Word. The Word brings it all to light.

The Verse of the Day: Alleluia. Alleluia. Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! Alleluia. Our hearts were burning within us while he talked with us on the road and opened the Scriptures to us. Alleluia. (Luke 24:32)

### The Gospel Reading: Luke 24:36-49

Jesus opens the Scriptures so that the disciples finally understand; without that miracle of the effective Word all remains darkness and foolishness. For how impossible everything he promised appears to reason! But with the effective Word, it all becomes both clear.

Applying God's Word to our Lives this Week:

Text: 1 John 1:8-2:2

Theme: God's Word Makes Us Doubly Sure!
We're sinful!
We're saved!

Holy Communion: In Holy Communion we are receiving Jesus' true body and blood for the forgiveness of our sins, new life, and salvation. But that's not all. We also receive strength, encouragement, and comfort knowing that in this sacrament we are at one with our God through Jesus' death on the cross for our sins, we are one in faith with those communing beside us, and we are joined with all the saints, who share our common faith. For this reason we practice close communion, inviting only WELS or ELS members to partake of the sacrament so as not to call into question the communion that we share.
