The Epistle Reading: 1 Corinthians 13:1-13

Usually heard at weddings, these verses, though, describe Christ's new command to lone one another as he has loved us.

The Verse of the Day: Alleluia. Alleluia. Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! Alleluia. I am the way, the truth, and the life, says the Lord. Alleluia. (John 14:6)

The Gospel Reading: John 13:31-35

Having come from God and now preparing to return to God, Jesus gives his disciples the command to love one another. For it is a reflection of the same love our now glorified Savior has for us.

Applying God's Word to our Lives this Week: Text: 1 Corinthians 13:1-13 Theme: What Makes Love So Great? **Holy Communion:** In Holy Communion we are receiving Jesus' true body and blood for the forgiveness of our sins, new life, and salvation. But that's not all. We also receive strength, encouragement, and comfort knowing that in this sacrament we are at one with our God through Jesus' death on the cross for our sins, we are one in faith with those communing beside us, and we are joined with all the saints, who share our common faith. For this reason we practice close communion, inviting only WELS or ELS members to partake of the sacrament so as not to call into question the communion that we share.
