# The Confession of Sins:

P: In the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Amen. Since we have gathered on this day of victory to worship our God, let us remember our unworthiness, confess before God that we have sinned in thought, word and deed, and realize that we can never free ourselves from the slavery of sin. Yet our merciful God has sent his own Son, to live a perfect life for us, and to die to free us from sin and Satan. And by raising Jesus Christ from the dead, he has assured us that we may come before him with confidence and know that he will answer our prayer of confession:

# All: Almighty God, have mercy on me. Forgive all my sins, for Jesus' sake. By his resurrection power lead me to life everlasting. Amen.

P: Having heard your confession, I as a called minister of God's Word assure you that God our Father in heaven has heard your prayer, and by the command of the Lord Jesus Christ I assure you that he has forgiven you all your sins. Peace be with you. Amen.

**EASTER SUNDAY** is the glorious "mountain peak" of our observance of the Church year. Everything in the "Festival Half" of the liturgical year points to this day--the Day of Victory.
