#### God speaks to us from the Scriptures:

The First Reading: 1 Samuel 3:1-10

God reveals himself at an important turning point in Israel's history and calls Samuel to the prophetic office.

The Psalm of the Day: Psalm 67, page 91 in your Hymnal

The Second Reading: 2 Thessalonians 2:13-17

It is the sanctifying work of the Spirit in the Word that calls and creates faith. The call remains glorious when it is translated into the life that follows faith. For that life always has its source, its inspiration, its direction, its strength to persevere in the Word.

**The Verse of the Day:** Alleluia. The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel. Alleluia. (Matthew 1:23)

#### The Gospel Reading: John 1:43-51

There is always a miraculous element in the call of Jesus. For anyone looking at him on the basis of appearance or reason will say what Nathanael said and turn away. In Nathanael's case Jesus read from a distance the thoughts of Nathanael and then promised even more wondrous things; he promised that Nathanael with the eyes of faith would see the fulfillment of God's promise of a Savior.

#### Applying God's Word to our Lives this Week:

**Text: 1 Samuel 3:1-10** 

Theme: What are we missing?

Holy Communion: In Holy Communion we are receiving Jesus' true body and blood for the forgiveness of our sins, new life, and salvation. But that's not all. We also receive strength, encouragement, and comfort knowing that in this sacrament we are at one with our God through Jesus' death on the cross for our sins, we are one in faith with those communing beside us, and we are joined with all the saints, who share our common faith. For this reason we practice close communion, inviting only WELS or ELS members to partake of the sacrament so as not to call into question the communion that we share.
