### God speaks to us from the Scriptures:

The First Reading: Isaiah 60:1-6

Isaiah knew the secret. He saw it all from a great distance away and he saw it bursting the bonds of time and space. Over the thousands of years thousands of people—a few here, a few there, but adding up to a mighty throng—would catch a glimpse of the glory that is Christ. They would come; we are in their number!

The Psalm of the Day: Psalm 72, p. 93 in your Hymnal

The Second Reading: Ephesians 3:2-12

It's all a mystery. No one can penetrate that mystery but the ones to whom God makes it known. And to whom does he want to make it known? He wants to make it known to all in these last days!

The Verse of the Day: Alleluia. We saw his star in the east and have come to worship him. Alleluia. (Matthew 2:2b)

### The Gospel Reading: Matthew 2:1-12

The glory of the Savior is hidden under veils and veils of mystery and still it is revealed. Mary and Joseph, poor people and virtual refugees in Bethlehem since the census, know the secret. The Magi, wise and rich, but Gentiles, know the secret. Everybody else in the story who should have known it best recognized it not at all.
