God speaks to us from the Scriptures:

The First Reading: Genesis 2:7-9, 15-17; 3:1-7

God had placed Adam into a perfect world and called on him to worship the Lord his God and serve him only. But Adam did not. He worshipped himself and ate the forbidden fruit, and so plunged the world into an age of darkness and death.

The Psalm of the Day: Psalm 130, page 114 in your Hymnal *The Church sings to God "out of the depths" and pleads for God's mercy.*

The Second Reading: Romans 5:12-19

Paul provides a New Testament commentary on the First Lesson and shows the universal effects of the First Adam's failure and the Second Adam's victory.

The Verse of the Day: It is written: "Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only." (Matthew 4:10)

The Gospel Reading: Matthew 4:1-11

The Second Adam goes to war to regain all that the first Adam had lost. Empowered by his baptism and led by the Spirit, Jesus defeats the devil for us.

Applying God's Word to our Lives this Week:

Sermon: Romans 5:12-19

Sermon Theme: The Mighty Fortress of our God

Holy Communion: In Holy Communion we are receiving Jesus' true body and blood for the forgiveness of our sins, new life, and salvation. But that's not all. We also receive strength, encouragement, and comfort knowing that in this sacrament we are at one with our God through Jesus' death on the cross for our sins, we are one in faith with those communing beside us, and we are joined with all the saints, who share our common faith. For this reason we practice close communion, inviting only WELS or ELS members to partake of the sacrament so as not to call into question the communion that we share.
