The First Reading: Joshua 7:16-26

The devastating effects of temptation are seen in the tragic story of Achan. Fresh from spectacular victory at the walls of Jericho, the Lord's anger burned against Israel. For the city was to have been devoted entirely to the Lord as the first spoils of Canaan. Yet some of the spoils were not given to the Lord. Witness the seriousness of the Word of the Lord and the hopelessness of our sin-stained obedience!

The Psalm of the Day: Psalm 91, on page 100 in your hymnal

The Epistle Reading: Hebrews 4:14-16

How easy it would be for us to cower in fear at the Lord's fierce anger against sin. For we are no better than Achan. We, too, have wandered from the way of the Lord to hoard and hide all that tempts. Yet the promise is sure: Jesus is our High Priest and has made atonement for our sin. We need not fear divine retribution. We can come in repentant confidence relying on the grace of God.

Verse of the Day: It is written: "Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only." (Matthew 4:10)

The Gospel Reading: Luke 4:1-13

Had Jesus failed to resist temptation, had he bowed, or jumped, or even simply made some bread...all would have been lost. But our Champion won the battle: Jesus the Christ holds the field and the kingdom is ours forever.
