God speaks to us from the Scriptures:

The First Reading: Isaiah 42:14-21

To his helplessly blind children who cannot find a way out, the Lord promises certain deliverance and rescue. God himself will lead them to safety and will turn their darkness into light. But to those who reject the true God and look to idols, God promises judgment!

The Psalm of the Day: Psalm 143, on page 118 in your hymnal

The Epistle Reading: Ephesians 5:8-14

Notice what Paul says. He does not say that once we were in the dark and now we are in the light. No, once we were darkness and now we are light. Our conversion meant a total transformation of what we are, and therefore, it will lead to a total transformation of what we do.

Verse of the Day: Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the desert, so the Son of Man must be lifted up, that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life. (John 3:14,15)

The Gospel Reading: John 9:1-7, 13-17, 34-39

The blind man could not see Jesus physically or spiritually. Christ opened the door to the latter by solving the former. It was no coincidence that this happened on the Sabbath. Christ had come not only to give sight to the helplessly blind—he also came to bring judgment on the Pharisees who but who refused to believe even what they saw with their own eyes

Applying God's Word to our Lives this Week:

Sermon: Romans 5:12-19

Sermon Theme: Jesus is the Light of the World In the face of suffering; in the face of doubts. Holy Communion: In Holy Communion we are receiving Jesus' true body and blood for the forgiveness of our sins, new life, and salvation. But that's not all. We also receive strength, encouragement, and comfort knowing that in this sacrament we are at one with our God through Jesus' death on the cross for our sins, we are one in faith with those communing beside us, and we are joined with all the saints, who share our common faith. For this reason we practice close communion, inviting only WELS or ELS members to partake of the sacrament so as not to call into question the communion that we share.
