The First Reading: Isaiah 45:22-25

The Psalm of the Day: Psalm 24, on page 73 in your hymnal

The Epistle Reading: Philippians 2:5-11

The homage due a king belongs to the Christ. At the name of Jesus every knee shall bow. For he has come to serve his people, not with armies and war machines, but with the obedient sacrifice of his own life. Therefore he is exalted by saints on earth and hosts of heaven.

The Verse of the Day: The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified. (John 12:23)

The Gospel Reading: Luke 19:28-40

Our humble King comes in majesty. For he comes to do the will of the Father. He comes to bring salvation, righteousness, and peace: peace in heaven and glory in the highest!

Applying God's Word to our Lives this Week:

Text: Matthew 21:12-17

Theme: The Ironies of the Passion:

Do you hear what these children are saying?

Holy Communion: In Holy Communion we are receiving Jesus' true body and blood for the forgiveness of our sins, new life, and salvation. But that's not all. We also receive strength, encouragement, and comfort knowing that in this sacrament we are at one with our God through Jesus' death on the cross for our sins, we are one in faith with those communing beside us, and we are joined with all the saints, who share our common faith. For this reason we practice close communion, inviting only WELS or ELS members to partake of the sacrament so as not to call into question the communion that we share.
