The First Reading: 1 Kings 19:3-8

As usual the visible demonstration of God's power had only a temporary and limited affect on those who saw it. Even Elijah soon forgot the proof of God's presence with him in that demonstration of power. What can restore his confidence? Only the Word!

The Second Reading: Ephesians 4:30-5:2

It is when we fail to grasp that the living Bread from heaven is everything and are deceived into thinking that the temporal is more important, it is then that we become bitter, frustrated, angry, greedy and grasping. For we never have enough of the visible and always see someone else who has more and deserves it less. But when we have everything because we have Christ and his grace, Christ and his forgiveness, Christ and his providential care, then we can afford and will eagerly strive to imitate him.

The Verse of the Day: Alleluia. Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see. Alleluia. (Hebrews 11:1)

The Gospel Reading: John 6:41-51

The Jews rejected the ultimate bread from heaven whose person, whose coming, whose dying, whose rising again is the only nourishment that matters.

Applying God's Word to our Lives this Week:

Sermon: Ephesians 4:30-32 Theme: A forgiving heart
