God speaks to us from the Scriptures:

The First Reading: Isaiah 6:1-8

In bringing us into his kingdom the Holy Trinity employs both the law and the gospel. The law shows us God in all his majesty and terror; it kills us and makes us despair of our own goodness. No, it is all his work and doing when he forgives our sins by purging that comes from his altar, ultimately the altar of the cross.

The Psalm of the Day: Psalm 150, page 122 in your Hymnal

Second Reading: Romans 8:14-17

In that kingdom of the Father, created by the work of the Son and brought to us by the Spirit in the gospel, we are not fear-driven slaves. No, so great is the love described in the gospel lesson that God even makes us his adopted sons.

Seasonal Response: Alleluia. Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory. Alleluia. (Isaiah 6:3)
