God speaks to us from the Scriptures:

The First Reading: Deuteronomy 5:12-15

There is no greater benefit to man in the law than this: God wants us to rest so that we may remember. Remember what? Remember all that he has done for us and for our salvation!

The Psalm of the Day: Psalm 126, p. 113 in your Hymnal

The Second Reading: 2 Corinthians 4:5-12

The whole point and purpose of our worship is to receive what God has come to give us in his Word. Therefore, let us not despise preaching and his Word but gladly hear and learn it, and thus receive its saving benefit: Christ!

The Verse of the Day: Alleluia. Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path. Alleluia. (Psalm 119:105)

The Gospel Reading: Mark 2:23-28

The Pharisees had turned even rest into a work! Jesus declares the true intent of the Sabbath law (the word Sabbath means rest). It was God's gift, not for God's benefit, but for our benefit. Its true and lasting rest is found in Christ and in his work; thus the worship of the New Testament is chiefly a worship not of doing but of receiving what God has done for us in his Word and sacraments.

Applying God's Word to our Lives this Week:

Sermon Text: Deuteronomy 5:12-15

Sermon Theme: Remember the Sabbath
For Your Good
Because of God's Goodness

Holy Communion: In Holy Communion we are receiving Jesus' true body and blood for the forgiveness of our sins, new life, and salvation. But that's not all. We also receive strength, encouragement, and comfort knowing that in this sacrament we are at one with our God through Jesus' death on the cross for our sins, we are one in faith with those communing beside us, and we are joined with all the saints, who share our common faith. For this reason we practice close communion, inviting only WELS or ELS members to partake of the sacrament so as not to call into question the communion that we share.
