God speaks to us from the Scriptures:

The First Reading: Genesis 2:18-24

Notice the love of God in the creation of Eve. God first shows Adam his need, that Adam's joy and thanksgiving may be increased when God supplies what is needed.

The Psalm of the Day: Psalm 139b on page 117 in your Hymnal

The Epistle Reading: Hebrews 2:9-11

This is how much God loves us! This is how much he yearns to have us as members of a heavenly and eternal family: He gave his Son, even unto death!

The Verse of the Day: Alleluia! I will proclaim your name to my people; in the midst of the congregation I will praise you! (Heb. 2:12) Alleluia!

The Gospel Reading: Mark 10:2-16

Divorce is a sin that separates not only the members of the marriage from one another, but the guilty member(s) of the marriage from God. Notice the connection between the two halves of the text: As children are gifts of God to a marriage, so are they also gifts to be brought to Jesus who gave them and loves them.
